The offender then smacked the complainant's wrist & fled into Suburban Station. The complainant followed the offender & flagged down Septa police. Septa took the report & made the arrest.*

The offender wrestled the purse away & got into the P/S of a white Dodge Avenger bearing a paper N.J. tag which fled N/B on 18th St. While inside C.D.D. the complainant received fraud alerts that her credit cards were being used at the Cherry Hill Mall. Cherry Hill P.D. were contacted & they observed a white Dodge Avenger bearing a paper plate #R795150 parked in the mall parking lot. They set up surveillance on the vehicle. While watching the vehicle they observed the brake lights come on, at which point they conducted a traffic stop before the vehicle could pull off. Offender #2 was in the driver seat w/ no one else being in the vehicle. Police observed a purple Givenchy purse laying on the back seat. Offender #1 was secured & surveillance was reestablished on the vehicle. A short time later offender #1 was seen approaching the vehicle & was stopped for investigation. The complainant was driven to the location where she positively identified the vehicle & offender #1 as the person who robbed her. The purse was recovered & the vehicle was towed to a Cherry Hill P.D. facility.*
