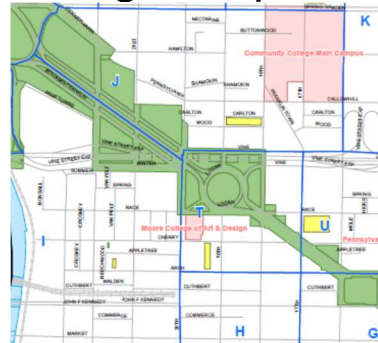

1/17 (6:35PM) **2400 MARKET ST. PSA 2 OFFENDERS: #1 B/M, TEENS, GREEN JACKET, GRAY BEANIE, DARK BLUE JEANS. #2 B/M LATE TEENS, RED JACKET, BLUE JEANS. (NO ARREST)** *The complainant was riding his bicycle when the offenders approached him. The offenders told him to “give me your fucking bike”. The complainant rode off & the offenders chased him. The complainant was able to ride away unharmed. C.D.D. is investigating.*

1/25 (9:00AM) **1500 MARKET ST. PSA 2 OFFENDERS: #1 B/M, #2 B/M, NFI (NO ARREST)** *The complainant states 2 unknown offenders started repeatedly punching him in the upper body area, forcing him to the ground. Offenders then took \$57 and 2 packs of cigarettes from complaint. C.D.D. is investigating.*

1/28 (5:05PM) **1700 JFK BLVD. PSA 2 (SUBURBAN STATION) OFFENDER: STACEY MURPHY, 47/B/M, 08/18/71, HOMELESS, PPN #0787937 (ARREST)** *The complainant states he & the offender were arguing over liquor money when the offender punched him & stole his money. Septa handled the job & made the arrest.*

After a foot pursuit, the offender was stopped & arrested at 2000 Ludlow St.*

(NO ARREST)** *The complainant reports the offenders assaulted him & stole \$20 USC from him. The complainant states he knows one of the males as "Money". C.D.D. is investigating.*

PSA 2 (7-11) OFFENDER: B/M, SALT & PEPPER BEARD, BLACK SKULLY, RED PANTS, BLACK BOOKBAG (NO ARREST)** *The complainant reports while inside the 7-11 the offender exchanged words with him. The offender then cut the complainant w/ a box cutter several times & stole his wallet before fleeing. The complainant was listed in stable condition at Hahnemann w/ lacerations. C.D.D. is investigating.*

The offender was stopped by police at 1600 Vine & positively identified. Recovered from the offender was jewelry & USC stolen from the apartment. Video shows the offender enter the building & checks various apartment doors to see if they are unlocked.*

The complainant fell to the ground & she was kicked & punched. The complainant was transported to Hahnemann by medic #31 for minor injuries. C.D.D. is investigating.*
