ROBBERIES WITH GUN

1500 Market – Concourse (7/7-1:18pm) (USC/Jewelry) MON

Compl B/F 31yrs states, while walking she was approached by 2 males, one put a hard object in her back then demanded her jewelry and cash. They fled on foot and were last seen getting into a cab at 17th & Walnut Sts.
