Theft From Auto prevention tips

- Theft from vehicles is one of the most easily prevented crimes. Do not leave valuables in plain view in your car, no matter where you park. It takes only a few seconds for a thief to smash your window and grab whatever is visible.
- GPS units along with iPod's are the items stolen most frequently.
- If possible, take all valuables with you or place them in your trunk before reaching your destination.
- Lock your car and park in a well-lit area. Report any suspicious activity that you see in parking lots or your neighborhood.

Theft From Auto Locations

The area around the following locations are high theft from vehicle zones. Extreme caution should be used when parking in these areas:

The Philadelphia Art Museum, Boat House Row, 2200 to 2900 Pennsylvania Avenue, The Franklin Institute, Rodin Museum, Academy of Natural Sciences, 1400 to 3000 Chestnut Street, 2300 to 3000 Market Street, Lemon Hill Area in Fairmount Park, 1400 to 2000 Vine Steet, 1400 to 1700 Race Street.
