



## Important Update about the Primary Election

Dear Fellow Philadelphians,

Governor Wolf and the Pennsylvania Legislature have postponed the Primary Election to **June 2, 2020**.

Here are the **new key election dates**:

Last day to register to vote before the primary	May 18
Last day to apply for a mail-in or civilian absentee ballot	May 26
Last day for County Boards of Elections to receive voted mail-in and civilian absentee ballots (must be <b>received</b> by 8:00 P.M.)	June 2

Here is an update about **poll workers**:

Out of an abundance of caution for our poll workers, staff and host locations, the Philadelphia City Commissioners are **cancelling all remaining poll worker training classes**. The City Commissioners will contact poll workers in the future with information about any rescheduled dates.

Here is information about **voting by mail**:

For the first time, you can vote by mail with no excuse in Pennsylvania. I urge you to apply for a mail-in ballot and encourage your networks to vote by mail too! There are **three simple steps**:

1. **Register to vote** at [register.votespa.com](https://register.votespa.com)
2. **Apply to receive your ballot by mail** at [votespa.com](https://votespa.com)
3. Once you receive your ballot, **complete it and mail it** back to the County Board of Elections
